

PowerTeacher Pro – What to expect

The first time you sign into PowerTeacher after having your sections upgraded to PowerTeacher Pro, you will see your sections listed a little differently where the class name has PowerTeacher Pro right below the name indicating that section is now managed in PowerTeacher Pro.

Clicking on the PowerTeacher Pro link in blue, opens the class in PowerTeacher Pro. The first time you open a class/section, you will be prompted to Migrate Data from the old gradebook to PowerTeacher Pro.

The Migrate Data page will display what classes have content that could be migrated. This is data you've already began working on in this term plus preferences you've set in your gradebook to be copied forward. Click on Migrate and the data will be copied forward. You can open these in the old gradebook if you launch it at this point but they will be read-only.

Summary

Click the Migrate button. This will initiate the migration process for the current year, and includes the following:

- All PowerTeacher Gradebook assignments and assignment scores are copied.
- All PowerTeacher Gradebook categories are copied.
- Applicable PowerTeacher Gradebook preferences are copied.

PowerTeacher Gradebook is still accessible in a read-only mode. After migration, verify that scores and grades are correct. Grade calculations may need to be configured in Settings.

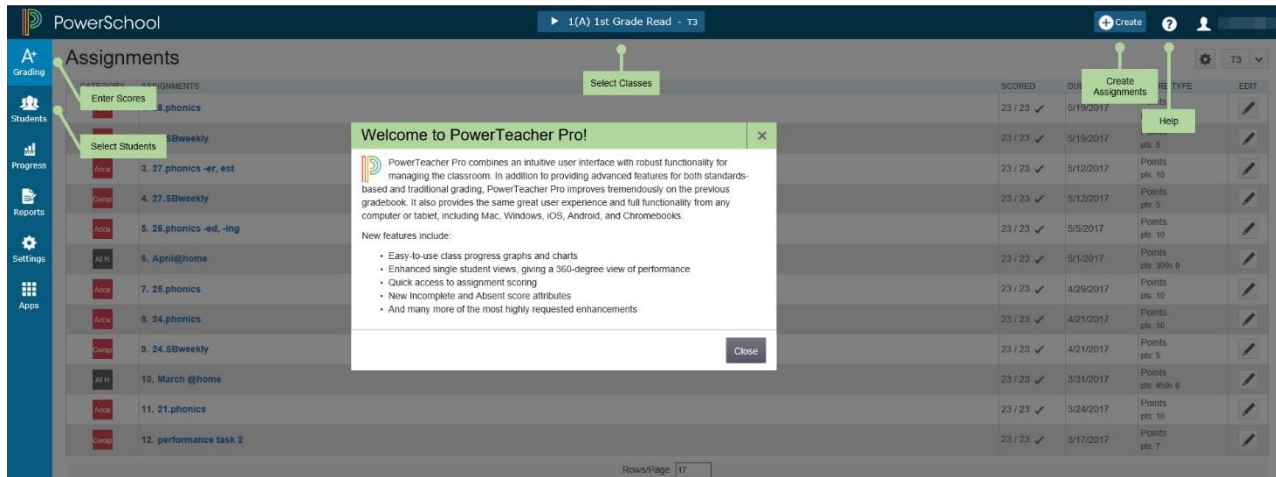

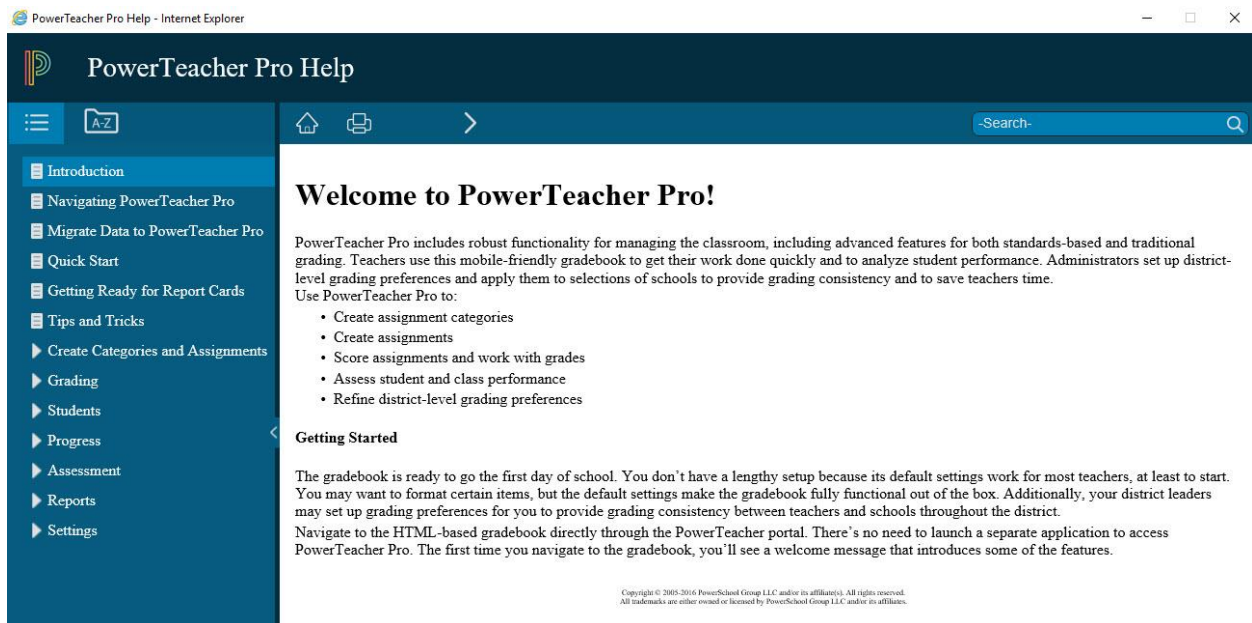
This is the first screen you will see when you open a class in Powerteacher Pro for the first time:
